Ms Harriet Adina PHILLIPS
For her courage in assisting with the rescue of three of four persons who were trapped in a bus which plunged from a precipice into the sea in Spring Gardens, Portland on the 18th of January 2008. Ms Phillips tried desperately to rescue the fourth person but was unsuccessful as the vehicle had begun to sink
